

MECHANICAL ENGINEERING SCIENCE ELECTIVES

Students entering the mechanical engineering program under the Fall 2007 curriculum (or later) are required to take two, four-hour laboratory based science electives.

One of the four-hour science electives **must be PHYS 2074**.

The other four-hour science elective must be chosen from one of the following:

BIOL 1543 & 1541L – Principles of Biology

BIOL 2213 & 2211L – Human Physiology

CHEM 1123 & 1121L – University Chemistry II

GEOS 1113 & 1111L – General Geology

PHYS 2094 – University Physics III

PHYS 3544 – Optics
